Arnold leaves behind a host of nieces, nephews and grandchildren that he loved dearly.



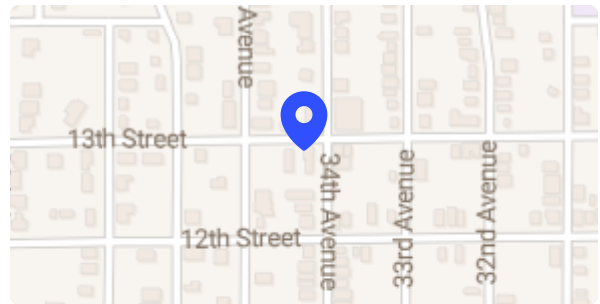

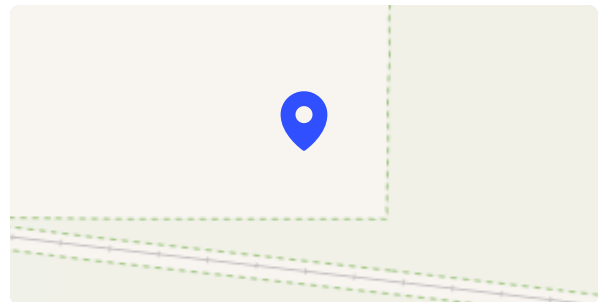

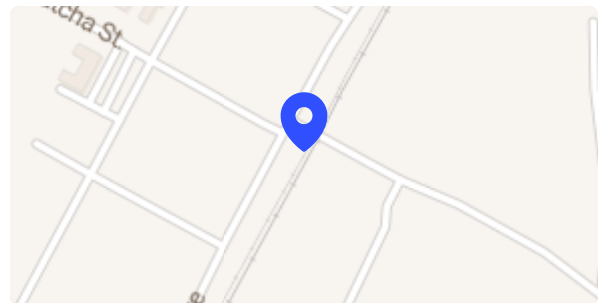
