# **Mrs. Catherine Ware DuBose Cole**

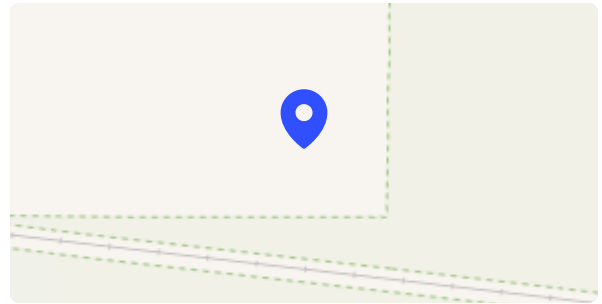
