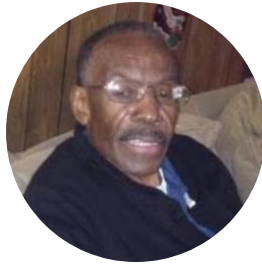

Levelle united with New Era Baptist church at an early age, under the pastorage of his father. Levene graduated from T. J. Harris High School in 1963. He was inducted into the Army In October 1966, and served in Vietnam War until October 1968. While in Vietnam, he fathered a daughter, Suzanne Erwin. After returning to Mississippi, he met and married Clemistine Griffin. To their union, they had two daughters, Sharon (Michael Ham) and Kesha (William Myles). He had three grandchildren: Cheniqia Erwin, Kyrah and William Myles II. He had one great grandson, Noah James. On January 26, 2002, Levelle and Dorothy Jones were married. 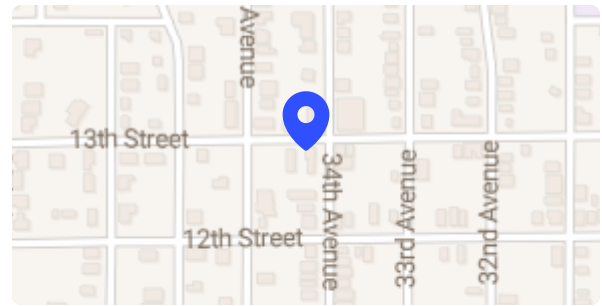
