Beatrice Gill Bonner was born on April 15, 1915 to the late Mr. Hugh and Leller Richmond Gill in Walnut Grove, MS. Beatrice joined Truelight Missionary Baptist Church in Walnut Grove, MS at an early age. She later joined Cokes Chapel United Methodist Church in Vossburg, MS where she was a faithful member until her health failed. Beatrice was one of fifteen children, all of whom preceded her in death, nine sisters: Alfie Wallace, Alice Bounds, Lou Willie Benjamin, Thelma Davis, Elma Rose, Jeffie Lee Hicks, Gladys Williams, Nona Griffin, and Lee Ester Gill. Five brothers: Jessie J. Gill, John D. Gill, Cleo Gill, Eugene Gill, and Jimmy D. Gill. Beatrice Bonner was united in Holy Matrimony around 1938 to the late Willie B. 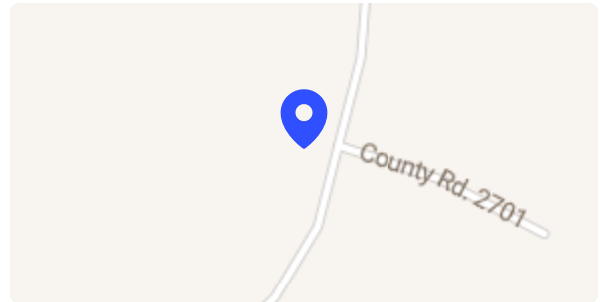
