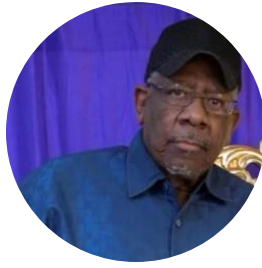

On Saturday, December 17, 2022, Robert went to be with the Lord peacefully.

God's hand had always been on his life. He confessed his faith in Christ as his personal Savior at an early age and joined Providence Baptist Church Electric Mills, Mississippi until it closed he then united with Bodka Valley Baptist Church where he later became a Deacon for many years until her resigned. He continued to be a faithful member.

Robert began working at a young age at the Dabbs Lumber Company until it closed. He then worked at Midland Manufactory Company for many years. After Midland went out of business, he started to work at James F. Webb Funeral Home for more than 20 years before retiring.
