Therresitta's family will receive a Presidential Memorial Certificate signed by President Biden to honor the memory of her service as a discharged veteran.






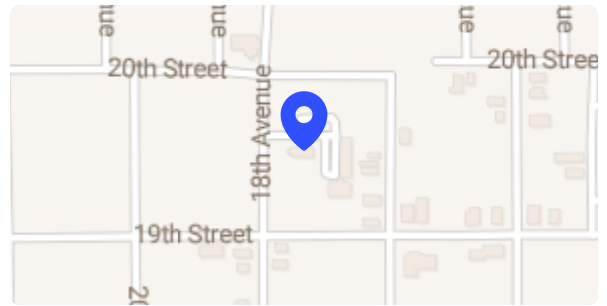

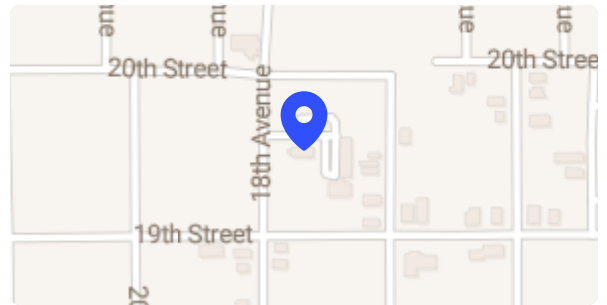
